- Funding study abroad semester/year
- For second- and third-year students
- Also: independently designed or organized programs

- All academic fields
- 4 to 10 months during the German academic year
- €650/monthly, insurance, travel stipend
- ***Deadline: January 31***

Intensive Language Courses in Germany

- Eight-week intensive courses at leading language institutes in Germany
- Open to students at Bachelor, Masters or PhD level studying in in any field of study **except German Studies, German Language & Literature, and German Translation & Interpretation**

Requirements

- Applicants must have German language skills to at least A1 level (two semesters of univ. German) and no higher than B1 (four semesters)
- Terms of Award:
Scholarship: €2,300; includes tuition, accommodation and a cash allowance, health insurance, travel subsidy

University Summer Course Grant

- Grant of €850 for summer courses taught in German at German Universities
- For undergraduates from 3rd year and Master's students
- Intermediate level German ability (at B1, Common European Framework = approx. 4 semesters of university German)
- Courses must be 3 to 4 weeks in duration
- Focus on literary, cultural, political and economic aspects

German Studies Research Grant

Program to encourage research into cultural, political, historical, economic and social aspects of modern and contemporary German affairs from an inter- and multidisciplinary perspective

Requirements

- Open to third or fourth year undergrads; Masters students or PhD candidates (working in Soc. Sciences or Humanities)
- Must be nominated by Department Chair & have completed four semesters of university level German (or equivalent) and three courses in German Studies (or with significant German content) at time of nomination
- Grant provides \$2,000 – 3,000 to offset living / travel costs in Germany

Deadline: early Nov. / early May

Your Application to DAAD

Tips for Success

- Express why your activities in Germany are critical to your academic or professional goals
- Show your passion: e.g. contact with and interest from German institution/professor
- **Submit quality letters of recommendation**
- Make sure your application is on time and complete



Group Study Visit

- ❁ **In Brief** Study visits in all disciplines to facilitate engagement with modern Germany
- ❁ **Who?** Full time Faculty can apply; 10 - 15 students + 1 faculty
- ❁ **Duration?** 7 - 12 days (trip may be longer)
- ❁ **Value?** EUR 50/day p.p. towards costs of accommodation & board



Conference Funding in German Studies

Co-funding to organize conferences, seminars, workshops and lecture series that embrace the interdisciplinary and/or comparative study of the history, politics, economics, law, society, culture and the arts of Germany.

A minimum of 50% of project costs must be contributed by other sources
